Neighbourhood Plan for Anstey

Parish Councils and local Communities now have the power to shape what their neighbourhood will look like in the future.

To do this Anstey Parish Council has decided to prepare what is known as a 'Neighbourhood Plan'. Once completed it will sit alongside Charnwood's new Local Plan, with equal weight in the planning system, to help shape future planning applications and development around locally determined priorities.

It will help to ensure that new housing or business development is managed in line with local need; local green spaces are protected from development and that heritage assets are safeguarded.

To drive this process forward over the next 12-18 months, we need YOUR involvement NOW to make sure that the Neighbourhood Plan truly reflects the wishes and vision of local people.

We want to hear from you about what is good or bad about living and working in Anstey and what needs to remain, improve and change.

The coming months will see a wide range of opportunities for you to have your say.
